THE KANE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ADOPTED RESOLUTION R-2020-18 A RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONVERT THE ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL BOARD OF THE CEDAR MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FROM AN ELECTED BOARD TO AN APPOINTED BOARD.

THE KANE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ARE HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DISCUSS THE CONVERSION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL BOARD OF THE CEDAR MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FROM AN ELECTED BOARD TO AN APPOINTED BOARD.

The boundaries of the "District" will remain the same. The Duties will remain the same and the requirements to serve be determined by state statute.

There will be no fee associated with a change in the conversion of the board, however fees are associated with the services that are rendered by this board.

The Public Hearing will be held November 10, 2020, AT 1:00 P.M. MOUNTAIN STANDARD TIME. THE MEETING will be held at the Kanab Center 20 N 100 E in the Kane School District Board room and may be moved to a larger room at the Kanab Center to facilitate social distancing. The public are welcome to give written or oral comments. Requirements for service on the board will follow the same state statute for service on the new board as they did on the elected board.

17D-1-206 allows for a protest in writing, explaining why the person is protesting; to be submitted to the County Commission no later than 60 days after the public hearing.
